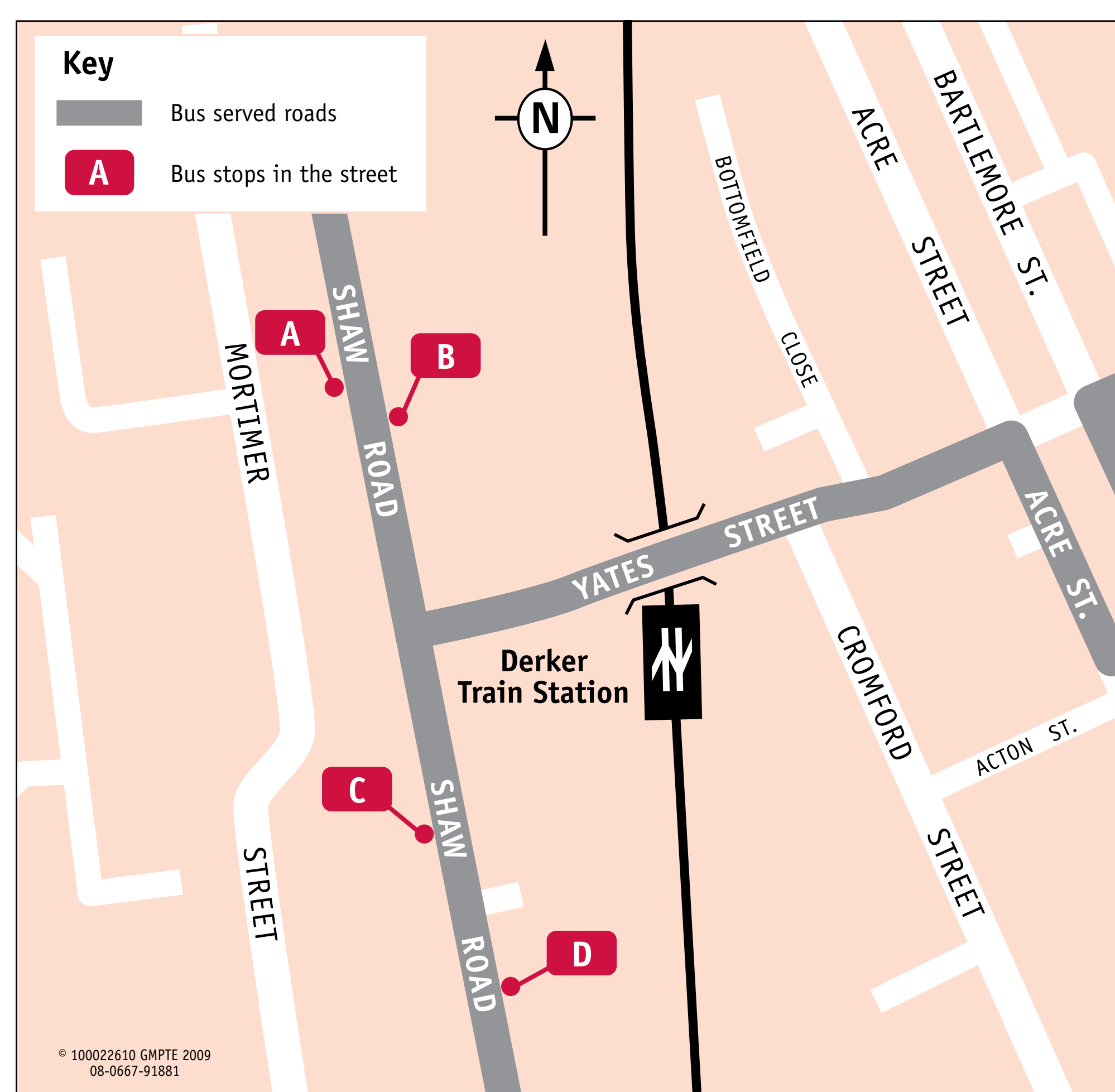
Oldham Loop Closure

In order to begin work on the expansion of the Metrolink tram network, **train services on the Oldham Loop Line will cease after the last train on 3 October 2009.**
